SENIOR MEALS

The Sevier County Office on Aging offers mobile meals to homebound seniors over 60 years of age. Once a week, volunteers deliver five frozen meals. The cost per meal is on a sliding scale based on the individual's income. Very low-income seniors may receive their meals at no charge. This also is an option for those on waiting list for Meals on Wheels program. For information contact Vicky Payne (865) 453-8080 x105.
